With an associate degree, you can go on to study a bachelor's degree, either straight away or at a later date.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Requirements for bachelor programmes

NHL Stenden University of Applied Sciences recognises the following general international qualifications:

- › High school / secondary school diploma from an accredited institution (a detailed list of recognised qualifications can be found on nhlstenden.com).
- › International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma, IB Career-related certificate of the International Baccalaureate
- › European Baccalaureate Diploma
- › General Certificate of Secondary Education in 4 subjects (A*-C) + a General Certificate of Education with 2 relevant subjects at advanced subsidiary level (A*-C) or 2 advanced levels (D-E), 6 different subjects in total.

Requirements for master's programmes

In general, you will need to have a relevant bachelor's degree (NLQF 6/EQF 6) from a recognised university in order to be admitted to one of the master's programmes at NHL Stenden.

Applications for NHL Stenden master's programmes will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis and NHL Stenden will consider your motivation letter and CV in its assessment. An interview may form part of the admissions procedure.

Language requirements

All non-EU applicants are required to submit an English proficiency test with their application. Exceptions are made for students who have had their preparatory education in a country where English is the official working and educational language. Students from some EU countries are exempted from submitting language test scores. Please check our website for up-to-date language requirements.

NHL Stenden University of Applied Sciences accepts the following language tests and certificates:

- › Academic IELTS 6.0 (with a recommended minimum of 5.0 for each skill)
- › TOEFL 550 (paper-based), 213 (computer-based) and 80 (internet-based). The TOEFL institution code for NHL Stenden is C652
- › Cambridge ESOL score FCE-C (169 or higher)
- › TOEIC 670 (Listening and Reading) and 290 (Speaking and Writing). We only accept TOEIC® certificates from public programmes and not from institutional programmes.
